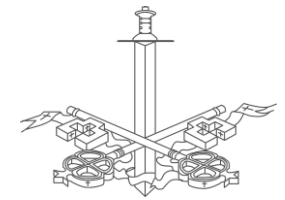

### Medicines in School

We ask that parents and carers note that only medicine which is prescribed by a doctor can be given in school.

Medicine has to be signed for by parents on a school consent form (available from the school office) in order for it to be given in school.

Please do not send your child to school with tablets or medicine. An exception to this is the use of inhalers for asthma – which your child may need to have to hand and also medication for diabetics.

### Internet Safety

We have received information from Wirral Council to remind parents of the need to ensure that relevant security is installed on iPads, tablets, laptops and mobile phones that are used by children.

This follows reported incidents, reported by police, of sites where children have been requested to join, that may lead to safeguarding issues.

Such sites are ooVoo and the ChaCha app, both of which have an age restriction of 13 to join.

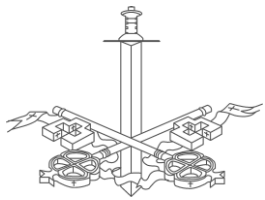
### Sporting Events

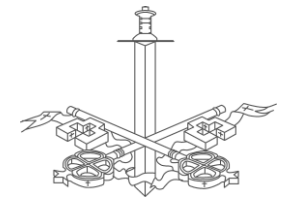
